Kia Ora

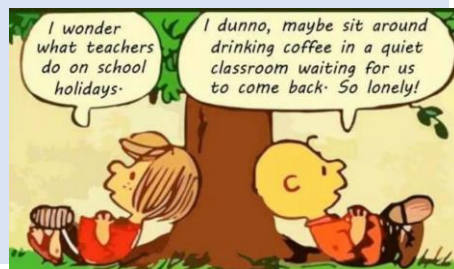
